


What habitats do we have?

Flowers and food

Food growing area (such as a veg garden)

- Fruit trees
- Flower beds
- Containers of plants
- Sensory garden
- Rockery

Hedges and bushes

- Any type of hedge
- Bushes or shrubs (that are shorter than the first floor of a house)





Fences

Walls (don't include the main walls of your building unless it has climbing plants)

Vertical features

- Structures for climbing plants (like trellis or pergolas)
- Green roof



Trees

- Single trees
 - Lines of trees
- Groups of trees
